# **National Russian Tumbler Master Breeder Program**

#### 1. Purpose

A. To give recognition to those Russian Tumbler breeders who put forth time and effort to breed and exhibit quality show type Russian Tumblers.

B. To give an incentive to the breeders of Russian Tumblers to show their birds.

### 2. Qualifications of Members

A. Must be a paid member in good standing with the National Russian Tumbler Club (as of 2024, must maintain their membership in the club to have points count).

B. Must be sure that all show results are sent to the club secretary and the appropriate district director and be capable of showing proof of the wins i.e. Show Reports. A form will be available for personal points record keeping from the club Master Breeder Coordinator, Joe Grau.

### 3. Win Qualifications

A. Wins must be spread out over 5 or more years.

B. All wins shall begin with the show season of 1990 (the secretary has most show results back to 1990 and will send out a master list; if some results are missing, he must be provided with results from the show secretary or the district director).

# (The show season is from March 1 through Feb. 29. Example: a show that is on Jan. 23, 2024, is in the 2023 show season.)

C. Exhibitor must have accumulated a minimum of 1000 points to be eligible

D. Entry should be bred and exhibited by the owner in order to collect points. Remember this is a Master Breeder's program.

E. A single bird can only contribute up to 250 points toward the final 1000 points.

F. There must be at least 2 different exhibitors, in order to qualify for points in color or age - Sex (OC, OH, YC, and YH) class wins.

## 4. Point Allotment

A. points will be awarded as follows:

## 5. Procedure

Small Show: 10 points for color or age-sex class winners

25 points for Reserve Champion
50 points for Champion

(*A small show is defined as having from 18 to 47 Russians with at least 2 exhibitors.)*Large Show: 20 points for color or age – sex class winners
50 points for Reserve Champion
100 points for Champion

(*A large show is defined as having a minimum of 48 Russians with at least 3 exhibitors.*)

A. Once the requirements are met, the club MB Coordinator will submit the information to the Executive Committee for approval

#### Additions to the MB Program:

1. Points recorded now for Second Reserve Champion of show will be the same as color or age – sex class points of that said show.

2. In a show where there aren't enough birds entered to form color or age – sex classes, points will be awarded as follows: 10 points each for OC, OH, YC, YH as long as there are 18 birds entered and 2 exhibitors in said class.
